Students will register for the class by paying \$215 to the city of Glendale. After successful completion of the class, students will be expected to pay \$42 by providing credit/debit card information directly to the American Red Cross. City staff will facilitate this process.

Instructors will be available on Friday, March 20 in the event a student needs to complete their final in water skills, or retake the Lifeguard test.

The in-person class held at Pacific Pool will consist of approximately 20 hours of classroom instruction and water skills in conjunction with approximately 7 hours of American Red Cross online content to be completed after the first in person class meeting (Mar 6) but before the second class meeting (Mar 13). Failure to complete online content prior to second in-person class meeting may result in dismissal from class without refund.
